

This is a request for records under the Federal Freedom of Information Act (FOIA), 5 USC § 552.

I am a private individual requesting copies of records in the custody or control of the USDA pertaining to the licensing and inspection of Angela M. Noland and Danny Lee Noland. The Nolands are former USDA licensees residing at 58758 Jasmine Road, Unionville, MO 63565.

Specifically, I am seeking:

1. A copy of the complaint referenced in the Consent Decision and Order against the Nolands jointly in AWA Docket No. 08-0012, "In re: Danny Lee Noland and Angela M. Noland". This complaint was filed in 2009 by the Administrator, Animal and Plant Health Service, USDA, alleging violations of the Animal Welfare Act. 2. Copies of any inspection reports for Danny Lee Noland and Angela M. Noland filed between January, 2006 and December, 2010.
