This is in response to your August 16, 2011, Freedom of Information Act (FOIA) request for copies of inspection reports before January 10, 2007, pertaining to the City of Dodge City, Kansas Zoo aka Wright Park Zoo, Certificate # 48-C-0140. Please be advised, we keep Animal Care reports for three years in accordance with Agency records retention guidelines. Therefore, Agency employees conducted a thorough search of their files, but were not able to locate any records responsive to your request.


You may appeal our no records determination. If you choose to appeal, your appeal must be in writing and must be received within 45 days of the date of this letter. Please send your appeal to:
