

**Re: Freedom of Information Request**

Pursuant to the Freedom of Information Act, 5 U.S.C. § 552, I hereby request a list of all genetically-engineered insects that have been approved by the Animal and Plant Health Inspection Service, the dates of the approvals, references to all Federal Register notices regarding the approvals, the purpose (s) for the approvals, a list of permits approved for the use of these organisms and dates of those approvals.

I am requesting these records as a representative of the non-profit consumer organization, Food and Water Watch.

I request a waiver of fees because my interest in the records is not primarily commercial, and disclosure of the information will contribute significantly to public understanding of the operations or activities of the government by showing how the Animal and Plant Inspection Service conducts its approval process for genetically-engineered insects.

I will expect a response within 20 working days as provided by law. If my request is denied in whole or in part, I expect a detailed justification for withholding the records. I also request any segregable portions that are not exempt to be disclosed.
