Agency employees conducted a thorough search of their files and located the enclosed eleven pages responsive to your request. Please note that we have withheld portions of the information pursuant to FOIA Exemption 6, 5 U.S.C. §§ 552 (b)(6). Exemption (b)(6) permit withholding of information which if released would cause a clearly unwarranted invasion of personal privacy. Specifically, we withheld personal addresses and the information identifying first party requesters.

You may appeal our partial denial determination. If you choose to appeal, your appeal must be in writing and must be received within 45 days of the date of this letter. Please send your appeal to:


