This is to acknowledge receipt of your letter dated September 14, 2008, Freedom of Information Act (FOIA) request received in this office on September 18, 2008 in which you requested all available inspection reports from January 1, 2007 to September 14, 2008, pertaining to University of Wisconsin as well as any violations from January 1, 2005 to September 14, 2008.

The records you seek are maintained outside of this Office and we have not yet been able to complete a search to determine whether there records within the scope of your request. Additionally, all Freedom of Information Act (FOIA) requests are processed on a "first-in, first-out" basis, according to track. Due to the large number of FOIA requests our Agency has been receiving, we have a considerable backlog, and unfortunately a number of requests still remain in queue. 
