
This is in response to your June 23, 2011, Freedom of Information Act (FOIA) request for copies of all FOIA logs for the Animal and Plant Health Inspection Service (APHIS) from January 2010 to present. Your request was received in this office on June 23, 2011, and assigned case number FOIA 11-593.

During a conversation on July 12, 2011, between you and Melinda Hill of my office you were informed that as of October 2010 FOIA logs are now accessible to the public at the following website: http://www.aphis.usda.gov/foia/foia_reading_room.shtml and there are no FOIA exemptions applied to the document. You stated that you still wanted the FOIA logs from January 2010 to September 2010 that is stated and you would take them without any exemption applied. As such, please find enclosed a CD-ROM containing the FOIA logs for January 2010 – September 2010.
