Dear Mr. Boyd:

This is in response to your November 24, 2010, Freedom of Information Act (FOIA) request for information on investigation #FL10221-PQ, regarding Citrus Black Spot disease. Your request was received in this office on November 24, 2010, and assigned case number FOIA 11-098.

Agency employees conducted a thorough search of their files and enclosed on CD-ROM are 73 documents that are responsive to your request. Information is being withheld under FOIA Exemption 6, 5 U.S.C. § 552(b)(6). This exemption protects information from disclosure when its release would cause a clearly unwarranted invasion of personal privacy.

Information is also being withheld under FOIA Exemption 7(C), 5 U.S.C. § 552(b)(7)(C). This exemption protects from disclosure records or information compiled for law enforcement purposes, the release of which could reasonably be expected to constitute an unwarranted invasion of personal privacy. Names, addresses and phone numbers have been withheld pursuant to exemptions (b)(6) and 7(C).

You may appeal our partial denial determination. If you choose to appeal, your appeal must be in writing and must be received at the following address within 45 days of the date of this letter:
