

Ms. King,

This email is sent pursuant to our telephone conversation and as a request for proof of two fines levied against Mr. Terry Mosley and Mr. Greg Butler by the USDA. Mr. Mosley and Mr. Butler appeared before me, the District Court of Choctaw County, Alabama, on August 4, 2009, and pled guilty to 18 different charges. As a result of their pleas, Mr. Mosley was fined a total of \$9415.00 and Mr. Butler was fined a total of \$8415.00.

In return for their pleas in DC-2009-392-402 and DC-2009-407-413, the State of Alabama agreed not to turn this matter over to the United States Government for Federal Prosecution. It is my understanding that these defendants have also been fined an additional \$3750.00 apiece by your department. It was my belief that at the time I levied the fines against these defendants, that the aforementioned amounts would be the total amounts owed by each of them based on these circumstances.

After learning of their new fines; however, I may be inclined to remit \$3750.00 from each of their amounts. Before I do this; however, I would like to have written proof to attach to my order to protect myself. As you can understand, I would feel much more comfortable with something from you department than just having testimony from one of the defendants.
