This is to acknowledge receipt of your letter dated April 21, 2010, which was received in this office on May 10, 2010, and assigned FOIA case number 10-436. You requested copies of all complaints, inspection reports, and the like regarding pests and/or bugs found with or on produce imported by Turbana Corporation on premises located at 535/567 Seaview Avenue Bridgeport, Connecticut, dated from February 21, 2006 through February 21, 2008. We apologize for the delay of this response.

Agency employees conducted a thorough search of their files and located 860 pages of responsive records which are on the enclosed CD-ROM. However, information is being withheld under FOIA Exemption 6, 5 U.S.C. § 552(b)(6). This exemption protects information from disclosure when its release would cause a clearly unwarranted invasion of personal privacy. Specifically, we withheld personal identifying information, such as names, photos, and phone numbers.

You may appeal our partial denial of this information. If you choose to appeal, your appeal must be in writing and must be received within 45 days of the date of this letter. Send to:


