Dear Mr. Porter/Ms. Robertson:

This is in response to your October 5, 2010, Freedom of Information Act (FOIA) request for all records concerning special needs requests submitted to APHIS pursuant to the Plant Protection Act (PPA) by any state, tribe, territory, or group of states, or other jurisdictions. This request includes various other related records. Your request was received in this office on October 6, 2010, and assigned case number FOIA 11-012. This is the third response to this request. We apologize for the delay in processing this request. This will be the final correspondence concerning this FOIA request. If this is not satisfied - a new FOIA request needs to be initiated with this office by you.

Agency employees conducted a thorough search of their files and located the 38 pages of responsive records to your request. Portions of information has been withheld under Exemption 6, 5 U.S.C. § 552(b)(6) of the FOIA. Exemption 6 permits the Government to protect from disclosure information that would cause a clearly unwarranted invasion of personal privacy. The release of this information will not shed any light on Government operations. Specifically, we have withheld the names and signatures of state agencies and/or various associations' employees from the enclosures.

You may appeal our partial denial of records. If you choose to appeal, your appeal must be in writing and must be received within 45 days of the date of this letter to:
