This is in response to your April 21, 2010, Freedom of Information Act (FOIA) request copies of all complaints, reports, inspection reports, investigation reports and the like regarding pest and/or bugs found with or on produce imported by Turbana Corporation found on premises located at 535/567 Seaview Avenue, Bridgeport, Connecticut for the time period covering February 21, 2006 through February 21, 2008. Your request was received in this office on April 29, 2010, and assigned case number FOIA 10-416. We apologize for the delay of this response.

Agency employees conducted a thorough search of their files and located the enclosed twelve pages of reports which are responsive to your request. We withheld the identities of third parties and law enforcement personnel under FOIA Exemptions 6 and (7)(C), 5 U.S.C. § 552(b)(6)(7)(C). FOIA Exemption 6 protects information from disclosure when its release would cause a clearly unwarranted invasion of personal privacy. Further, this same information has been withheld pursuant to FOIA Exemption 7(C). This exemption protects from disclosure records or information collected for law enforcement purposes when its release could reasonably be expected to constitute an unwarranted invasion of personal privacy.

The program office has advised that they are no complaints or investigations records found on Turbana Corporation listed on your request.

You may appeal our partial denial determination. If you choose to appeal, your appeal must be in writing and must be received within 45 days of the date of this letter. Please send your appeal to:
