This is in response to your September 28, 2010, Freedom of Information Act (FOIA) request for copies of Adverse Reaction Reports to Lyme Vaccine, dated June 1, 2009 to September 30, 2010. Your request was received in this office on September 28, 2010, and assigned case number FOIA 10-691.

Agency employees conducted a thorough search of their files and located nine pages of documents that are responsive to your request. However, information is being withheld under FOIA Exemption 6, 5 U.S.C. § 552(b)(6). This exemption protects information from disclosure when its release would cause a clearly unwarranted invasion of personal privacy.

You may appeal our partial denial determination. If you choose to appeal, your appeal must be in writing and must be received at the following address within 45 days of the date of this letter:
