This is our second partial response to your November 18, 2010, Freedom of Information Act (FOIA) request for data regarding adverse events during 2009 for specific canine 5—way vaccines: DuraMune - Fort Dodge Animal Health, Vanguard 5 - Pfizer Animal Health, Galaxy 5 - Schering Plough, and Solojec - Boehringer Ingelheim and the number of doses produced in 2009. Your request was received in this office on November 18, 2010, and assigned case number FOIA 11-091. We apologize for the delay of this response.

Accordingly, please find enclosed a CD-ROM containing an additional 198 pages of responsive records. However, information has been withheld under FOIA Exemption 6, 5 U.S.C. § 552(b)(6).
