Subject FOIA Request - Second Submittal of Request

This is my second (2nd) request to your office under the Freedom of Information Act, 5 U.S.C. Sec. 552.

I request that a copy of the following documents [or documents containing the following information] be provided to me: I would like copies of any adverse reaction reports involving felines and Pfizer vaccinations, as well as any and all studies, reported cases, and findings from Pfizer (as well as any of their subsidiaries) involving vaccine associated cancer, which may be known as fibrosarcoma, osteosarcoma, fibrous histiocytoma, rhabdomyosarcoma, liposarcoma, chondrosarcoma and undifferentiated sarcoma. The time period of my request is January 1, 1998 to the present.

In order to help to determine my status to assess fees, you should know I am an individual seeking information for personal use and not for commercial use.

I request a waiver of all fees for this request. Disclosure of the requested information to me is in the public interest because it is likely to contribute significantly to public understanding of the operations or activities of the United States Department of Agriculture and is not primarily in my commercial interest. Other people will also want copies of the documents and that it is unfair to make the first requester bear the full cost of the initial search for the material.

My interest in the requested documents is related to a Vaccine Associated Sarcoma diagnosis in my pet Amelia "Boo Kitty" Corkern and I will not derive any income from the requested documents.

The public will benefit from the requested documents as there appears to be an increase in Vaccine Associated Sarcomas but there is not any data available for concerned pet owners to review in order to make an informed decision regarding vaccinating their feline family members.

The information provided to me will be posted on a website for the general public to review to become educated about adverse vaccine reactions in felines.


