This is in response to your March 16, 2011, Freedom of Information Act (FOIA) request all documentation of adverse reaction reports for involving felines and Pfizer Vaccinations as well as any and all studies, reported cases, and finding form Pfizer involving vaccine associated cancer which may be known as fibrosarcoma, osteosarcoma, fibrous histiocytoma, rhabdomyosarcoma, liposarcoma, chondrosarcoma and undifferentiated sarcoma dating from January 1, 1998 to the present. Your request was received in this office on March 16, 2011, and assigned case number FOIA 11-337.

Agency employees conducted a thorough search of their files and we have enclosed a CD-ROM containing 297 pages of records responsive to your request. However, information is withheld pursuant to FOIA Exemption 6, 5 U.S.C. § 552(b)(6). This exemption protects information from disclosure the release of which would cause a clearly unwarranted invasion of personal privacy. We withheld owner and third party information.

Also contained on the CD-ROM are copies of your request, this response letter, and Adobe® Acrobat® Reader™, which is needed to view the responsive records. By opening rp505enu.exe and following the on-screen instructions, you will install Adobe Reader. After the installation, the Adobe Reader should render the PDF files correctly.

You may appeal our denial of this information. If you choose to appeal, your appeal must be in writing and must be received within 45 days of the date of this letter. Send to:

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
