Dear Mr./Ms. Ghandour:

This is in response to your March 25, 2011, Freedom of Information Act (FOIA) request which was received in our office on March 29, 2011, and assigned case number 11-361. You requested documents regarding or related to Morris Hatchery, Inc. located in Goulds, Florida. Specifically, you requested the following:

1. National Poultry Improvement Plan (NPIP) Test Result Reports from July 2009 through July 2010;
2. NPIP Test Reports from July 2009 through July 2010;
3. All reports of Salmonella Isolations to NPIP Official State Agencies (VS Form 9-6) from July 2009 through 2010;
4. All Investigations of Salmonella Isolations in Poultry (VS 9-7) from July 2009 through July 2010;
5. Any official suspensions or warnings made by NPIP to Featherland Farms regarding health status from July 2009 through July 2010; and
6. All requests for Salmonella Serotyping (VS Form 10-3) from July 2009 through 2010.

Agency employees conducted a search of their files and located the enclosed 15 pages of reports from states (Arkansas, Florida, and Georgia) where Morris Hatchery is known to be. These pages are responsive to Items 1 and 2 of your request and are being released to you in their entirety. No records were found for Items 3-6.
