This is our third partial response to your August 29, 2011, Freedom of Information Act (FOIA) request in which you requested all owner/shipper papers and VS 17-145 forms of horses shipped to slaughter by or for Brian Moore/Moore's Menagerie of Pennsylvania from January 1, 2005, to the latest date of records. Your request was received in our office on August 29, 2011, and assigned case number FOIA 11-804.

Accordingly, please find enclosed a CD-ROM containing an additional 251 pages of releasable records. However, information has been withheld under FOIA Exemption 6, 5 U.S.C. § 552(b)(6). This exemption protects information from disclosure when its release would cause a clearly unwarranted invasion of personal privacy. Specifically, we withheld vehicle tag numbers, identification numbers, driver's names, and signatures.
