This is in response to your December 18, 2010, Freedom of Information Act (FOIA) request seeking information in items #1 through #8 of your request which pertains to the goose management at Bend's Drake Park on June 29, 2010. Your request was received in this office on December 20, 2010, and assigned case number FOIA 11-146. We apologize for the delay in processing your request.

In connection with a previous FOIA request, access is granted in part to 110 pages of newly responsive records which are contained on the enclosed CD-ROM. However, information is being withheld under FOIA Exemption 6, 5 U.S.C. § 552(b)(6). This exemption protects information from disclosure when its release would cause a clearly unwarranted invasion of personal privacy. We withheld cooperative representative names, account numbers, and social security numbers.

Although we are not required to generate new documents or answer non-FOIA questions; a little insight is provided below:

- Request item #1: Records for this question have already been submitted to you in case number FOIA 11-042. No new records exist.
- Request items #2 and #8: Records for these items are combined as they could answer both questions. There is information within these records that are not responsive to the request and have been indicated.
- Request item #3: No records exist for this item.


