This is in response to your January 11, 2011, Freedom of Information Act (FOIA) request for all documents and information that discusses the death of wolf 314F in Spring 2009 in Rio Blanco County, Colorado by Compound 1080. This includes all communications between USDA-APHIS and U.S. Fish and Wildlife Services (FWS). Your request was received in this office on January 11, 2011, and assigned case number FOIA 11-180. We apologize for the delay in processing this request.

Agency employees conducted a thorough search of their files and enclosed is a one-page responsive record to your request. We are releasing this document without any redactions affixed.
