I ARRIVED AT THE SITE AT 012:10 ON 10-15-07. (b)(6) WERE PRESENT. I FOUND SEVERAL WOLF TRACKS OF DIFFERENT SIZES AROUND THE AREA AND ONE LARGE CANINE SCAT AT THE CARCASS. ALSO A LARGE WOLF SCRAPE ABOUT 50 YARDS FROM THE CARCASS AT A GATE. THE CARCASS WAS LOCATED AT A SALT GROUND. I FOUND SEVERAL SPOTS OF BLOOD ON THE GROUND AND ON THE WHITE SALT. ALSO DRAG MARKS IN A 20 YARD AREA. THE CARCASS WAS ABOUT HALF TO TWO THIRDS EATEN. ON PERFORMING NECROPSY, I FOUND NUMEROUS CANINE BITES AND RAKES ALONG WITH CORRESPONDING HEMORRHAGE ON THE FRONT SHOULDERS AND HIND LEG CONSISTANT WITH MEXICAN GREY WOLF, THERE WAS ONE HIND LEG MISSING.  
 ON A HILL ABOVE THE SITE I GOT A STRONG TELEMERTY SIGNAL ON (b)(3) GENE WHETTEN STATED THAT HE HAD A VISUAL ON (b)(3) THE EVENING OF 10-13-07 ABOUT 2 MILES FROM THE SITE. HE ALSO HAD TELEMERTY ON (b)(3) AT 09:00 ON 10-15-07. BUT DID NOT THINK TO TRY (b)(3) AT THE TIME. RULED CONFERMED MEXICAN GRAY WOLF KILL.

<b>SUMMARY OF INCIDENT (including preface and actions taken):</b>					
Arrived on site on 6-29-07 at 015:00 on inspection of site we found numerous wolf tracks in & around the kill site. 40 yards up hill from the carcass there were drag marks & signs of struggle down to the carcass. The calf was laying with his back up hill with his feet under the log. The calf could not regain his footing from the way he was laying. Wolves fed first around flank area. On performing necropsy we found bite marks on the back next to tail head that are consistent with Mexican gray wolf. On the morning of the kill the range rider had a visual on (b)(3) 100 yards south of the kill sight. WS Mike Kelly & Jed Murphy helped investigate the kill.

<p>This incident occurred at the (b)(6) a friend and neighbor of the (b)(6) went to feed and check on the horses at the (b)(6) when he discovered the horse in the corral on 1-9-07. (b)(6) had been there on Friday 1-6-07. I was notified about 12:00 noon and arrived at 4:15pm on 1-9-07. (b)(6) and Saleen [NMDGF] were waiting for the (b)(6) at the turn off to the residence. (b)(6), Saleen and I walked from the gate down to the house and corral; I saw wolf tracks in the road app 200 yards as we walked in. The area between house and corral [app 60 yards], I saw horse, mule and wolf tracks running in all directions, it was muddy so sign was easy to see. Saleen and I entered the corral through the closed east gate. The corral was matted with wolf tracks, The stomach content and a large amount of dried blood was on the north side, the bones and hide on the south side of the corral. The carcass and 80 to 90% of the hide was eaten, The hide was twisted like a rope I scraped mud and ice off the hide with my knife and took two canine measurements 46.39mm and 46.37mm. The west gate was open with one set of horse tracks entering and numerous wolf tracks coming in and going out. I saw wolf scat out side the west gate in the pasture. The forest road coming from the south, two to three miles south of the house had numerous wolf tracks and scat in the road for a mile or more.</p>

<p>On November 2, 2007 xxx resource owner and manager of the xxx Ranch took me to a dead calf that he had found. Once there I observed a charolais calf mostly consumed. All that was left was the hide, a few bones and a little flesh. I scraped what flesh that was on the hide off and I observed multiple bite and rake marks. At the site I could see disturbed ground that continued for 15-20 yards where a struggle between predators and the calf had occurred. There was a large pool of dried blood where the calf was brought to the ground. Later I drove to meet Mike Kelly with the hide. We shaved the hide and he then soaked the hides in order to better observe. After which measurable bite mark was found on the rear left leg that measured 38.30 mm. It is my conclusion that the calf was brought down, terminated, and fed upon by more than one Mexican Gray Wolf. Tracks at site indicated the presence of pup wolves.</p>
