This is in response to your May 20, 2011, Freedom of Information Act (FOIA) request for records about a "golden eagle that was reported unintentionally killed or euthanized in California, identified in an APHIS online report titled Table G. Animals Taken by Wildlife Services -FY 2009." Your request was received on May 23, 2011, and assigned case number 11-519.

The Office of Wildlife Services (WS) conducted a search of their files and located three pages responsive records. These pages are being released in their entirety.

Although this does not constitute a denial because no records were found or withheld, you may appeal this determination within 45 calendar days from the date of this letter. An appeal must be submitted in writing to: Administrator, Animal and Plant Health Inspection Service, Ag Box 3401, Washington, DC 20250-3401. Please refer to **FOIA 11-519**, in your appeal letter and add the words "FOIA Appeal" to the front of the envelope. To assist the Administrator in reviewing your appeal, provide specific reasons why you believe modification of the determination is warranted.
