Dear Mr. Kingry:

This is in response to your August 11, 2011, Freedom of Information Act (FOIA) request for all records regarding any correspondence between the USDA and Western Henrico County, Virginia, regarding the geese population and all site visits to the Canterbury Lake neighborhood in Western Henrico County. Your request was received on August 11, 2011, and assigned case number 11-749.

The Office of Wildlife Services (WS) conducted a search of their files, and enclosed are 86 documents responsive to your request. Specifically, we have enclosed a copy of the Cooperative Service Agreement, work and financial plans, bill of collection, emails, and other correspondence. These documents are about all WS wildlife damage management activities in Henrico County, not just Canterbury. Pursuant to Exemption 6, 5 U.S.C. § 552(b)(6) of the FOIA, all names, home addresses, telephone numbers, email addresses of private landowners, including WS investigators are redacted/withheld. This exemption protects information from disclosure when its release would cause a clearly unwarranted invasion of personal privacy.

You may appeal our determination of your request. If you choose to appeal, your appeal must be in writing and must be received within 45 days of the date of this letter to: Administrator, Animal and Plant Health Inspection Service, Ag Box 3401, Washington, DC 20250-3401. Please refer to FOIA 11-749 in your appeal letter and add the words "FOIA Appeal" to the front of the envelope. To assist the Administrator in reviewing your appeal, provide specific reasons why you believe modification of the determination is warranted.
