ATTENDING VETERINARIAN AND ADEQUATE VETERINARY CARE (DEALERS AND EXHIBITORS).

Sec. 2.40 Attending veterinarian and adequate veterinary care (dealers and exhibitors)

(b) Each dealer or exhibitor shall establish and maintain programs of adequate veterinary care that include:

(2) The use of appropriate methods to prevent, control, diagnose, and treat diseases and injuries, and the availability of emergency, weekend, and holiday care.

***In the outdoor facility there are 3 adult dogs that present with moderate matting of hair to the chest area. If left unattended, skin irritation and other issues may occur.

The owner needs to maintain a program of grooming techniques that show the appropriate methods that are being used to prevent and control diseases in order to be in compliance with this regulation.

Affects 3 adult dogs.

To be corrected by July 7, 2008.

***In the middle building, on the left side, last pen on the top, there is an adult male dog that has slight hairloss just beneath his right eye. The owner state he is approximately 8 years old.

The owner needs to contact the attending veterinarian and follow recommendations to show that appropriate methods are being used to prevent and control diseases in order to be in compliance with this regulation.

Affects 1 adult dog.

3.6 (a) (2) (i)

PRIMARY ENCLOSURES.

Sec. 3.6 Primary enclosures.

(a) General requirements.

(2) Primary enclosures must be constructed and maintained so that they:

(i) Have no sharp points or edges that could injure the dogs.

***In the outdoor facility, on the furthest building to the left, and the wooden building, there are at least 4 primary enclosures that have sharp points from wire. These points could cause potential injury to the dogs inside of these enclosures.

The owner needs to remove or repair the wire in these enclosures to ensure an effective maintenance program is being used to protect the dogs from injury in order to be in compliance with this regulation.

Affects 10 adult dogs.

3.11 (b) (2)

CLEANING, SANITIZATION, HOUSEKEEPING, AND PEST CONTROL.

Sec. 3.11 Cleaning, sanitization, housekeeping, and pest control.

(b) Sanitization of primary enclosures and food and water receptacles.

(2) Used primary enclosures and food and water receptacles for dogs and cats must be sanitized at least once every 2 weeks using one of the methods prescribed in paragraph (b)(3) of this section, and more often if necessary to prevent an accumulation of dirt, debris, food waste, excreta, and other disease hazards.

***In the 2 buildings behind the barn there is a moderate amount of mineral buildup beginning to show on the hinged doors and the walls of the primary enclosures.

The owner needs to maintain a program of sanitization at least once every 2 weeks or more often as necessary to prevent an accumulation of dirt, debris, and other disease hazards in order to be in compliance with this regulation.

Affects all the dogs in these 2 buildings.
