



### 3.6 (c) (1) (i)

#### PRIMARY ENCLOSURES.

Section 3.6(c)(1)(i) - Each dog housed in a primary enclosure (including weaned puppies) must be provided a minimum amount of floor space, calculated as follows: Find the mathematical square of the sum of the length of the dog in inches (measured from the tip of its nose to the base of its tail) plus 6 inches; then divide the product by 144. The calculation is: (length of dog in inches + 6) x (length of dog in inches + 6) = required floor space in square inches. Required floor space in inches/144 = required floor space in square feet.

- There were puppies housed in enclosures that did not meet the minimum standards for floor space as indicated above. There were twelve runs housing puppies in the building. The facility had two sizes of enclosures in these runs. The puppies housed in the larger enclosures were in compliance with this paragraph. The small enclosures measured 22 inches by 24 inches for a total of 3.67 square feet. This is the maximum floor space available in those enclosures - any combination over that is out of compliance. There were a total of 255 small enclosures housing two puppies in these runs. There were a total of 397 small enclosures housing one puppy in these runs. There were a total of 147 empty small enclosures in these runs. Run numbered "8" had an additional 100 empty small enclosures.

The run numbered "2" was picked as a representative of all the other runs. In this run, there were 28 cages housing two puppies, 35 cages housing one puppy, and three empty cages. All puppies housed as pairs in this run were measured as follows:

Cage 35 - Pomeranians: 11 inches and 10 inches in length, total floor space needed = 3.78 square feet

Cage 38 - Yorkshire Terriers: 10.5 inches and 10.5 inches in length, total floor space needed = 3.78 square feet

Cage 42 - Yorkshire Terriers: 10.25 inches and 10.75 inches in length, total floor space needed = 3.78 square feet

Cage 44 - Pomeranians: 9.75 inches and 11 inches in length, total floor space needed = 3.73 square feet

Cage 47 - Chihuahuas: 10 inches and 9.75 inches in length, total floor space needed = 3.50 square feet

The puppies in the other eleven runs were not measured. The puppies in the other eleven runs were similar (breeds and size) to the puppies in run 2.

All animals must be housed in enclosures that meet the minimum floor space as defined above. The licensee must ensure that these animals are placed in larger enclosures if housed as pairs, or housed as a single animal in the current enclosures. The licensee must ensure that all animals are housed in the appropriately sized enclosure.

\*\*\*\*6 puppies were accepted for sale and transport at a remote meeting site. The puppies were from a litter of Jack Russell Terriers, dob 10/07/07. The date of disposition was 11/30/07, thus the puppies were only 54 days of age (56 days at 12/02/07). Transportation of underage puppies is harmful to them because of young immune systems being exposed to many foreign antigens and the stress of transportation decreases the ability of the immune system to be protective. For the health and well being of puppies, the licensee and their agents and employees must be more diligent in checking the age of the puppies before accepting them for transportation. Underage puppies can not be accepted.

This affects 6 underage puppies at this time.

The trailer unit (MO Registration #854727) was cited twice for brake violations: Citation (1) "inoperative/defective brakes", Citation (2) "brakes(general)-pins missing from push rods, rendering brakes inoperative". A third citation was issued for "operating a CMV (MO Registration #854727) without periodic inspection-periodic inspection expired on 8-1-06". The two tractor-trailer drivers, employees of the registrant, were also cited for "no pretrip inspection-inadequate pre-trip insp. failed to notice disconnected brake push rods on semi trailer". On 8/14/06, the MA State Police Commercial Vehicle Enforcement Section placed the trailer unit under an "Out of Service" order which meant that the trailer unit could not be operated until repairs were made to the cited items. The animal cargo space of primary conveyances must be maintained in a manner that protects the health and well-being of the animals transported therein. The facility must address the maintenance of this primary conveyance. Correct before transporting any animals in this trailer unit

NOTE: On 8/15/06, between 11:30-17:00, two USDA inspectors visited the location where the trailer was impounded. The carcasses of the puppies had been removed from the trailer unit. The drivers were unavailable for interview.


