This is in response to your August 18, 2010, Freedom of Information Act (FOIA) request for a list of all FOIA requests that the United States Department of Agriculture, APHIS received from June 11, 2010 to present. You would like the following to be included:

- 1) The request number

- 4) The first and last name of the requester

- 6) Description of the records requested.

Your request was received in this office on August 18, 2010, and assigned case number FOIA 10-633.

Agency employees conducted a thorough search of their files and enclosed on CD-ROM are 24 documents that are responsive to your request. However, information is being withheld under FOIA Exemption 6, 5 U.S.C. § 552(b)(6). This exemption protects information from disclosure when its release would cause a clearly unwarranted invasion of personal privacy.

You may appeal our partial denial determination. If you choose to appeal, your appeal must be in writing and must be received at the following address within 45 days of the date of this letter:


