This is in response to your February 3, 2010, Freedom of Information Act (FOIA) request for all information available on Robanns Nest, 5024 Stephen Lane, Durham, North Carolina. Your request was received in our office on February 3, 2010, and assigned case number FOIA 10-234.

Agency employees conducted a thorough search of their files and enclosed is a CD-ROM with 36 pages of consisting of applications for license and renewal letters, licenses, inspection reports, official warning notice for violations, Report of Investigation, and Settlement Agreement. However, information has been withheld under FOIA Exemption 6, 5 U.S.C. § 552(b)(6). This exemption protects information from disclosure when its release would cause a clearly unwarranted invasion of personal privacy. This same information has also been withheld under FOIA Exemption 7(C), 5 U.S.C. § 552(b)(7)(C). This exemption protects from disclosure records or information compiled for law enforcement purposes when its release could reasonably be expected to constitute an unwarranted invasion of personal privacy. Specifically, identities of various federal employees and the owner's signature have been withheld.

You may appeal our denial determination of this information. If you choose to appeal, your appeal must be in writing and received within 45 days of the date of this letter. Send to:
