

Please provide the Lot Release Protocols for the testing of these final products.

PETA is entitled to a fee waiver because the release of the public records will contribute significantly to the public's understanding of the agency's administration and because the release is not in the commercial interest of PETA, as defined by 5 U.S.C. § 552(a)(4)(A)(iii). The legislative history of the public interest fee waiver standard "clearly indicates" that Congress intended to create a test that was to be "liberally construed," and was "consistently associated with requests from journalists, scholars, and non profit interest groups who it intended to benefit." *Ettlinger v. FBI*, 596 F.Supp. 867, 872 (D. Mass. 1984) (emphasis added).
