This is in further response to your May 19, 2010 Freedom of Information Act (FOIA) request for copies of seventy seven Form 3-177 Declaration packages. Your request was received in this office May 19, 2010 and assigned case number FOIA 10-462. We apologize for the delay of this response.

United States Department of the Interior. Fish and Wildlife Service employees conducted a thorough search of their files and located five pages of responsive records, originating from the U.S. Department of Agriculture, which are enclosed. However names and identifiers have been withheld under FOIA Exemption 6, 5 U.S.C. § 552(b)(6). This exemption protects information from disclosure when its release would cause a clearly unwarranted invasion of personal privacy.

You may appeal our partial denial of this information. If you choose to appeal, your appeal must be in writing and must be received within 45 days of the date of this letter. Send to:
