RECORDS REQUEST

To whom this may concern:

Pursuant to the State Open Records Act as well as the Freedom Of Information Act, I request access to and copies of medical records and tank inspection records as they pertain to the Killer Whale (Orcinus Orca) referred to as "Lolita" being housed at the following address;

Furthermore we are requested fully detailed records including but not limited to the following.

- Diet; including any and all supplements or medications being given
- Reproductive (including but not limited to failed pregnancies and stillbirths)
- Mental Health Assessments

- Dental Health Assessments (including drilling or filling and filing of teeth)
- Emergency Medical
- Tank Water Testing: including but not limited to: Bacteria/Parasite counts
- Tank Maintenance
- APHIS/AWA/USDA inspection reports including measurements and violations and remarks past and present.
- APHIS/AWA/USDA approved emergency contingency plan for the Miami Seaquarium in case of a natural disaster or other cause that would concern life support of the marine animals at that facility.

We're requesting all records as they pertain to "Lolita" from **date: August 6, 1970** (estimated date of capture/purchase by Miami Seaquarium/Wometco Enterprises) through **date: current**.

As these are public records requested by a non-profit entity for the purpose of helping a marine mammal in distress we're asking that there be no fees incurred during the record retrieval and shipping process but are willing to pay \$4.95 USD for priority flat rate mailing of said records to the following address:
