Dear Ms. Stearns:

This is in response to your January 14, 2011, Freedom of Information Act (FOIA) request for the following information:

“Complaint filed with USDA with a follow up letter by Vernon Yates on 2/13/2008, concerning Big Cat Rescue for choking a tiger on 5/18/2007 while transporting tiger from Savage Kingdom to Big Cat Rescue. CD from Fox 13 news and a CD of still shots from video were also distributed.”

Your request was received in this office on January 14, 2011, and assigned case number FOIA 11-190. We apologize for the delay of this response.

Agency employees conducted a thorough search of their files and located 13 pages of responsive records which are enclosed on the CD-ROM. However, information that is personal in nature has been withheld pursuant to Exemption 6 of the FOIA, 5 U.S.C. § 552(b)(6). This exemption protects information from disclosure when its release would cause a clearly unwarranted invasion of personal privacy. In addition, we withheld the same information under FOIA Exemption 7(C), 5 U.S.C. § 552(b)(7)(C). This exemption protects from disclosure records or information collected for law enforcement purposes when its release could reasonably be expected to constitute an unwarranted invasion of personal privacy.

You may appeal our partial denial of this information. If you choose to appeal, your appeal must be in writing and must be sent within 45 days of the date of this letter to:


