This is in response to your February 28, 2011, Freedom of Information Act (FOIA) request for a list of all individuals, partnerships, limited liability partnerships, corporations, limited liability corporations, and any other entities who received tickets for violations of the HPA between March 1, 2010 to October 31, 2010. Your request was received in this office on February 28, 2011, and assigned case number FOIA number 11-290.

Agency employees conducted a thorough search of their files and enclosed on CD-ROM are 117 pages of responsive records. These records are appropriate for release in their entirety, without redactions.
