

The surfaces of housing facilities--including perches, shelves, swings, boxes, houses, dens, and other furniture-type fixtures or objects within the facility--must be constructed in a manner and made of materials that allow them to be readily cleaned and sanitized, or removed or replaced when worn or soiled.

***The den boxes in the primate enclosures are bare plywood. Bare wood allows urine and feces to be absorbed and cannot be readily cleaned and sanitized. The floors in all the interior portions and outside portion of those with concrete floors are not sealed. Concrete is a porous material that will absorb the urine, feces, and food as indicated by the dark stains on the floors. All surfaces must be made of materials that allow them to be readily cleaned and sanitized. This affects 30 animals.

HOUSING FACILITIES, GENERAL.

(c)(3) Cleaning. Hard surfaces with which nonhuman primates come in contact must be spot-cleaned daily and sanitized in accordance with Sec. 3.84 of this subpart to prevent accumulation of excreta or disease hazards. All other surfaces of housing facilities must be cleaned and sanitized when necessary to satisfy generally accepted husbandry standards and practices. Sanitization may be done by any of the methods provided in Sec. 3.84(b)(3) of this subpart for primary enclosures.

***The spider monkey enclosure near the house has algae growing on the floor. Enclosures must be cleaned and sanitized often enough to prevent build up of contamination such as algae. The owner indicated the enclosures were only being cleaned every other day or four times a week. Spot cleaning must be done on all surfaces that come into contact with the primates. Cleaning is necessary to promote the health and well-being of the animals. This affects 30 animals.

(d) Pest control. An effective program for control of insects, external parasites affecting nonhuman primates, and birds and mammals that are pests, must be established and maintained so as to promote the health and well-being of the animals and reduce contamination by pests in animal areas.

***There is an excessive amount of flies in the primate barn near the gift shop. Flies can contaminate food sources and spread disease. An effective method of pest control must be establish to promote health and well-being of the animals. This affects 14 animals.

(a) The food shall be wholesome, palatable, and free from contamination and of sufficient quantity and nutritive value to maintain all animals in good health.

***The meat in the serval food dish is contaminated with live maggots. Uneaten fresh meat fed to the animals should be removed from the enclosure within 12 hrs during the heat of the summer to prevent contamination or spoiling. Contaminated food is not an acceptable food source to maintain good health of the animal. This affects 2 animals. This was corrected during the inspection.

FEEDING.

(b) Food receptacles shall be kept clean and sanitary at all times.

***The food dish in the serval enclosure is caked with dried on food and dirt. Food receptacles must be cleaned often enough to prevent contamination of food but at a minimum of every two weeks. This affects two animals. This was corrected during the inspection.



There is at least one of the metal guides for the sliding metal door that separates the inside from the outside portions of the enclosure housing two snow leopards in the old tiger building that is rusted to the point that the structural integrity is jeopardized and rusted jagged edges are present. This shall be repaired so the animals in this enclosure are protected from potential injury from the jagged edges and to ensure the animals are securely contained. Correct by 13 June 2011.
