(c) Drainage. A suitable method shall be provided to rapidly eliminate excess water. The method of drainage shall comply with applicable Federal, State, and local laws and regulations relating to pollution control or the protection of the environment.

Standing water was noted in the area between the tufted and black/white capuchin enclosures on the east side of the property. The water ran the entire length of the enclosure sides and did not accumulate from recent enclosure cleaning. Standing water can become a breeding ground for microbes and vermin and the proximity of this water to the animal enclosures increases the risk of adverse health effects. A method of eliminating excess water must be implemented.

*A primary enclosure housing 5 adult tigers is constructed of heavy gauge chain link with 12 foot high walls and no kick in. The enclosure has no top. Historically, it has been demonstrated that healthy adult tigers, when appropriately motivated, are able to access the tops of enclosures which are only 12 feet high. Adult tigers may also possess a vertical jump dimension which exceeds 12 feet. The tigers contained in this primary enclosure with 12 foot chain link walls and no kick in are at risk for escape. This enclosure must be modified to ensure the animals are securely contained.

*The chain link east wall of the primary enclosure housing the Watusi, sheep and goats is damaged in the middle section at the bottom. A metal horizontal support running the length of the bottom of the enclosure is damaged in this area and the chain link has separated from the support with a resulting gap in the enclosure wall. The animals could become entangled in the gap or the loose chain link and possibly escape the enclosure if the gap enlarges. Primary enclosures must be maintained in good repair to protect the animals from injury and to contain the animals.



On October 15, 2008, I conducted an inspection of licensee 58-B-0306, Zoological Imports, 2000, Inc. The president, Mario Tabraue, accompanied me during this inspection. Earlier in this week I had been contacted by Megan Adams, ACI, requesting that I trace the location and paperwork connected with 2 tiger cubs that had reportedly been transported by (b)(6), (b)(7)(c) from out of state to Mario Tabraue in Florida.

Upon arrival to Mr. Tabraue's facility on 10/15/08 I advised him I was conducting his routine inspection which was due, including a records check and in particular any movement of large cats on or off his property. After inspecting the physical facility, I obtained copies of 7020's from Mr. Tabraue. One 7020 dated 10/02/08 documented the transfer/donation of 2 cubs from licensee 56-C-0116, by an employee (b)(6), (b)(7)(c) at the Miami location, to Mr. Tabraue. The other 7020, dated 10/03/08, documented the transfer/donation of 1 cub from Mr. Tabraue to (b)(6), (b)(7)(c) Mr. Tabraue stated he completed both documents and sent a copy to licensee 56-C-0116. I asked him multiple times if the transactions took place as documented and he stated they did.

I advised Mr. Tabraue that I had been provided with information that in fact (b)(6), (b)(7)(c) had transported the 2 tiger cubs from licensee 56-C-0116, (Bhagavan Antle) from South Carolina or some other northern state to Mr. Tabraue in Florida. Mr. Tabraue denied this and suggested he get (b)(6), (b)(7)(c) on the phone in my presence to discuss the matter. He engaged (b)(6), (b)(7)(c) on his cellular phone and advised him his USDA inspector was present and conducting an inspection. Mr. Tabraue told (b)(6), (b)(7)(c) the USDA was questioning the transfer of the cubs because we had information that he had made a trip to visit B. Antle. (b)(6), (b)(7)(c) was then placed on speakerphone. He stated he had made a trip to the Boston area to view a show by Antle but that it had been cancelled due to weather. He stated he did not bring the cubs to Florida. I inquired why (b)(6), (b)(7)(c) would say that he had transported them. Mr. Tabraue put Thunderhawk on mute to ask me who (b)(6), (b)(7)(c) was. After a brief exchange with Mr. Tabraue he returned to speak with (b)(6), (b)(7)(c) he was no longer on the phone. Mr. Tabraue attempted to reach him several times but was unsuccessful.

I believed Mario Tabraue's statement and documentation regarding the transfer and transport of the tiger cubs. Therefore, his inspection report reflected all items in compliance during the October 15, 2008 inspection.
