- Establish and maintain programs of adequate veterinary care that includes daily observation of all animals to assess their health and well-being. Daily observation of animals may be accomplished by someone other than the attending veterinarian.**

(Signals and behaviors exhibited by a pregnant marmoset indicated the animal was in distress. Timely and accurate information was not conveyed to the attending veterinarian.)

Titles 7 & 9 Code of Federal Regulations were promulgated to help prevent the spread of animal and plant pests and diseases and assure the humane treatment of animals. Since violations of the regulations can have serious and costly impact detrimental to the public interest, you are warned of this violation. Any further violation of these regulations may result in the assessment of a civil penalty or criminal prosecution.
