Dear Ms. MacNair:

This is in response to your August 24, 2011, Freedom of Information Act (FOIA) request for copies of travel itineraries and records that indicate the date that the itineraries were submitted to the agency for the following two USDA-licensed exhibitors that include travel for the months of August and/or September 2011:

- 1.) Kay Rosaire's Big Cat Encounter (certificate number 58-C-0367); and
- 2.) Banana Derby, owned and operated by Gilligan T. Monkey, LLC, (certificate number 33-C-0247).

Your request was received in this office on August 24, 2011, and assigned case number FOIA 11-793.

Agency employees conducted a thorough search of their files, but were not able to locate any records responsive to item number 1 (Kay Rosaire's Big Cat Encounter, certificate number 58-C-0367) of your request. Regarding to item number 2 (Banana Derby, certificate number 33-C-0247) of your request, the search located two responsive pages which are being released to you with this letter. However, information has been withheld under FOIA Exemption 6, 5 U.S.C. §552 (b)(6). This exemption protects information from disclosure when its release would cause a clearly unwarranted invasion of personal privacy. Specifically, we have withheld the telephone numbers pursuant to this exemption.

You may appeal our partial denial determination. If you choose to appeal, your appeal must be in writing and must be received at the following address within 45 days of the date on this letter. Please send to:
