Agency employees conducted a thorough search of their files and located the enclosed two pages responsive to your request. Please note the documents are being provided to you in their entirety without redactions.


You may appeal the adequacy of our search. If you choose to appeal, your appeal must be in writing and received within 45 days of the date of this letter to the following address:


