Dear Mr. Braswell:

This is in response to your November 2010 Freedom of Information Act (FOIA) request for the weekly reports, (VS) 8-35 and itineraries of Dr. Joana Davis. Your request was received in this office on November 10, 2010, and assigned case number FOIA 11-079.

Agency employees conducted a thorough search of their files and we have enclosed a CD-ROM containing 32 pages of records responsive to your request. However, information is withheld pursuant to FOIA Exemption 6, 5 U.S.C. § 552(b)(6). This exemption protects information from disclosure the release of which would cause a clearly unwarranted invasion of personal privacy

Also contained on the CD-ROM are copies of your request, this response letter, and Adobe® Acrobat® Reader™, which is needed to view the responsive records.
