This is in response to your August 8, 2011, Freedom of Information Act (FOIA) request for and all records pertaining to Dennis or Donna (Gussie) Kunz from Williard, Utah between January 1, 2011 to August 8, 2011. Your request was received in this office on August 8, 2011, and assigned case number FOIA 11-718.

Agency employees conducted a thorough search of their files and enclosed are 29 pages of responsive records. However, information is being withheld under FOIA Exemption 6, 5 U.S.C. § 552(b)(6). This exemption protects information from disclosure when its release would cause a clearly unwarranted invasion of personal privacy. Specifically, signatures have been withheld under this exemption.


You may appeal our denial determination. If you choose to appeal, your appeal must be in writing and must be received at the following address within 45 days of the date of this letter:
