This is in response to your October 14, 2010, Freedom of Information Act (FOIA) request for a copy of any wildlife assessments and correspondence, decisions, or references about wildlife use and airport management on or around the Mustang Airport in South Sacramento County, California. Your request was received in this office on October 14, 2010, and assigned case number FOIA 11-027.

Agency employees conducted a thorough search of their files and located the enclosed three pages of documents that are responsive to your request. However, information has been withheld pursuant to FOIA Exemption 6, 5 U.S.C. § 552(b)(6). This exemption protects information from disclosure when its release would cause a clearly unwarranted invasion of personal privacy.


You may appeal our partial denial determination. If you choose to appeal, your appeal must be in writing and must be received within 45 days of the date of this letter to:
