This is in response to your May 13, 2011, Freedom of Information Act (FOIA) request which was amended on June 3, 2011, for all records from FY2010 until the present time for Wildlife Services' operations for the lethal and nonlethal control of predators. Your initial request was received in this office on May 17, 2011, and assigned case number FOIA 11-501.
