







To make your own ash tree ID poster! Follow this grid to redraw the ash leaf in a larger size.

A Bug's Life (Cycle) Can you follow the **Emerald Ash Borer Beetle (EAB)**'s life cycle? The female EAB lays an egg . When the egg hatches, a larva emerges. The larva burrows into the tree, where it begins to feed and develop under the bark. As it feeds, it makes S-shaped tunnels that damage the tree. Eventually the

larva turns into a pupa 👯 and then an adult EAB News. The adult EAB chews

through the bark and escapes (), leaving behind a D-shaped exit hole

When the egg hatches, a larva emerges and burrows under the bark. Start the maze as a larva, and finish as an adult EAB. Good luck! Cood luck!




