- 4.1. Exported birds were examined by the veterinarian issuing the certificate within 30 days prior the exportation and showed no evidence of communicable disease of poultry at the moment of inspection.
- 4.3. The exported birds did not originate from flocks nor had contact with any birds or poultry originated from a control zone established by the animal health authorities due to outbreaks of Newcastle disease or Highly Pathogenic Avian Influenza (HPAI) in the 90 days preceding the exportation.
- 4.4. The exported birds were not vaccinated against any H5 or H7 subtype of avian influenza.


The exported birds were inspected by the veterinary authority of the exporting country within the 24 hours prior to departure and did not present evidence of communicable diseases among them.
