CHAPTER 7.3.

TRANSPORT OF ANIMALS BY LAND

**Preamble:** These recommendations apply to the following live domesticated *animals*: cattle, buffaloes, camels, sheep, goats, pigs, *poultry* and equines. They will also be largely applicable to some other *animals* (e.g., deer, other camelids and ratices). Wild, feral and partly domesticated *animals* may need different conditions.

**Rationale:** We are unable to identify a scientific basis for differentiating transport recommendations for partially or otherwise domesticated animals.
