## Import Requirements for Fig fruit From Mexico Grown in Fruit Fly Free Areas

- ◆ **Import Permit Required:** An import permit is required. To obtain a permit, go to e-Permits.
- ◆ **Commercial Consignments Only:**
- ◆ **Do not** import or distribute into Hawaii, Puerto Rico, U.S. Virgin Islands, and Guam.
- ◆ Cartons **must** be stamped "Not for importation or distribution within PR, USVI, HI, or Guam."
- ◆ Accompanied by a Mexican phytosanitary certificate with the additional declaration stating that "These regulated articles originated from an [area free from pests](#) as designated in 7 CFR 319.56-5."
- ◆ Boxes **must** be labeled with the name of the orchard or grove of origin, or the name of the grower, AND the name of the municipality and State in which the fruits were produced.
- ◆ Fruit **must** be sealed if they originated in a fruit fly free area but transited an area not listed as fruit fly free.
