

## Additional Import Requirements for Cold Treated Citrus fruit from Mexico into North Atlantic Ports:

### NOTICE

These additional import requirements are limited to grapefruit (*Citrus paradisi*), tangerine, clementine, mandarin (*C. reticulata*), tangelo (*Citrus x tangelo*), sweet orange (*C. sinensis*).

- ◆ Consignments are allowed entry into North Atlantic ports only.
- ◆ Require cold treatment T107-b at an APHIS-approved cold treatment facility in the North Atlantic region of the US (ports north of 39 latitude and east of 104 longitude) or at a port listed in 7 CFR 305.6(h).
- ◆ Cold treatment cannot be initiated in Mexico.
- ◆ Must be accompanied with a phytosanitary certificate (PC) issued by Sanidad Vegetal with an additional declaration (AD) stating that "The citrus in this consignment were cleaned using normal packing house procedures."
- ◆ **AUTHORIZED USERS ONLY:** Refer to the "Inspection procedures for cold treated commodities" in the "Instructions for Officers" section.
