

Additional Import Requirements for Mango fruit From Mexico Grown in a Fruit Fly Free Area into All Ports

Mango from Mexico is admissible into all U.S. ports with the following additional import requirements:

- ◆ Consignments are allowed entry into all ports.
- ◆ Consignments must be accompanied by a Mexican phytosanitary certificate (electronic certificates are acceptable) with the additional declaration: "These regulated articles originated from [an area free from pests](#) as designated in 7 CFR 319.56-5."
- ◆ Boxes must be labeled with the name of the orchard/grove/grower AND the name of the municipality and State in which the fruits were produced.
- ◆ Fruit must be sealed if they originated in a fruit fly free area but transited an area not listed as fruit fly free.
