
Additional Import Requirements for Mango fruit from Mexico Treated with Vapor Heat or High Temperature Forced Air into All Ports

- ◆ Consignments are allowed entry into all ports.
- ◆ Consignments must be treated at an APHIS-approved facility in Mexico.
- ◆ Consignments must be precleared and accompanied by a completed PPQ Form 203 (yellow or white) or an electronic message signed by the APHIS inspector in Mexico confirming treatment.
- ◆ Each box must be marked with the statement “USDA APHIS treated with vapor heat (if T106-a-3), or high temperature forced air (T103-a-1).”
