

**Guidance for containment evaluation of arthropod/snail permit applications when containment is required.**

Type	Movement	Evaluation
1. Unknown and/or unidentified regulated organisms (actual or suspected)	Importation	Full
2. Field-collected regulated organisms	Importation	Full
3. Not established species/subspecies of invertebrate regulated organisms.	Importation	Full
4. Pure cultures of not established species/subspecies of large invertebrates where intended use does not include rearing or propagation, and the organisms must be killed within a short period of time following receipt.	Importation	Cafe
5. Pure laboratory or commercial cultures of not established species/subspecies of regulated organisms.	Importation	Cafe/Full Evaluation of each application will be made on a case by case basis.
6. Subsequent movement of a regulated organism (not previously approved for environmental release) that was previously imported into an inspected facility and required an inspected facility for receipt.	Interstate	Full
7. Movement of a quarantine significant regulated organism under official control from a quarantine area to a non quarantine area	Interstate	Full
8. Movement of a native or established regulated organism including geographically isolated variants or subspecies (not approved for environmental release) to an area where it does not presently occur	Interstate	Cafe/Full Evaluation of each application will be made on a case by case basis

9. Movement of organisms that were brought into the State under a Federal permit that required the facility that initially received it to be inspected by USDA and which possesses a condition statement that requires a Federal permit for any subsequent movement.	Intrastate	Full
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
