Basis for changes to the Pale Cyst Nematode (PCN) Regulated Area February 23, 2015

The following changes have been made to the PCN regulated area since the December 29, 2014 publication:

As a result of infested field detections in October 2014, approximately 2,387 acres of farmland in Bingham county have been added to the regulated area due to their primary association with an infested field, in accordance with the PCN Rule, subpart 301.86-3(c)(2)(iii) *Criteria for designation of fields as infested fields and associated fields - Associated fields*. The locations of fields added to the regulated area are as follows: Bingham County-- T 02 S, R 36 E, sections 3, 9, 10, 11, 12, 13, 14, 15, 22, 26, and 27; T 02 S, R 37 E, sections 1, 7, 8, 12, 17, and 18.

Corrections to the mapped boundaries of two Bingham County fields resulted in the subtraction of approximately 5 acres from the regulated area. The locations of adjusted field boundaries are as follows: Bingham County—T 01 N, R 37 E, sections 34 and 36.

Together, these changes bring the current regulated area to 10,116 acres, of which 2,897 acres are infested fields.
