The export of U.S. agricultural commodities to Iran, with some exceptions, is generally authorized by a General License issued by the U.S. Department of the Treasury's Office of Foreign Assets Control (OFAC). Current regulations on the General License for agricultural commodities can be found in <u>31 C.F.R. Part 560.530</u> and frequently asked questions can be found at the <u>OFAC FAQs Iran Sanctions page</u>. Exporters who wish to export agricultural commodities that are not covered by the General License may apply to OFAC for a specific license. However, exporters should be aware that there are no bilaterally agreed upon trade protocols for the export of animal origin commodities. Therefore, there may be limited recourse should a consignment be detained and/or denied entry.
